

Coastway to Runway--- 'Early Bird' Bus Service



Gatwick Airport launches “Early Bird” Bus Services. Following a recent business study that highlighted the need for early morning bus services from both the Bognor Regis and Hasting areas, Gatwick Airport has teamed up with Metrobus and Southern Railway to create two new bus routes.

The new daily services are designed to encourage passengers to use public transport instead of driving to the airport. The new bus routes will allow passengers flying from Gatwick to arrive at the airport in time to catch early morning flights

These services are also designed to support existing airport staff living in the areas to get to work on public transport, along with opening up new opportunities for employers in and around the Gatwick area to recruit further afield. The project is led by Gatwick’s Surface Transport Division working with partners Metrobus and Southern Railway

Two journeys on each route are scheduled to arrive at the airport (North and South terminals) at approximately 03:30 and 05:30 to cover early flights departures, and shift times. A dual ticket is available allowing passengers to travel to the airport on the bus and return by train.



A single one way ticket will be £7.00, a day return £11.00 (to Gatwick by Bus, return by train) and a weekly ticket £50.00

The route numbers are, from Hastings “380” and from Bognor Regis “320” Both services are branded – Metrobus Early Bird, Coastway to Runway.
